The issue was reported to NRW's 24 hr-7 days per week emergency service at Welsh headquarters. The Clerk spoke to the Mr Sando Citra at the DEFRA site office on 13 March. Mr Citra explained that the controlling mechanism was in the process of being changed. Mr Citra had reported the current issue to Defra Head Office (Michael Garrod) on 10 March 2023. Members may recall that in October 2001 flooding of the Rhydymwyn village, took place as a result of the obstructions on the flood gate, resulting in 68 houses and 8 business premises being flooded.
