- 13/06 Stakeholder meeting Rhydymwyn Flooding Copy of update from Richard Dearing (NRW People and Places Officer). Please note that Mr Dearing does not mention the cleaning of the catch pits either side of the Defra Grille.
 - Members may consider it appropriate to note that the cleaning of the catch pits is more important to Rhydymwyn villagers than the cleaning of the culvert by the 'triples', the location of the 'triples' being approximately half a mile down river of the Defra Bridge. At this 0.5 mile distance, flooding of the river is going to have less of a detrimental impact on Rhydymwyn residents than not cleaning the catch pits.
